With this as its purpose, a charter was secured, by-laws adopted, and today an association of 800 members, who are employed as enforcement officers and are of Italian origin, have dedicated themselves to fulfilling the creed of this association.

Ken Lavorata IAPA 2023 Man of the Year

Ken Lavorata served in the Marine Corps from 1964-67, including a tour of duty as a battalion scout in Vietnam from 1965-66. He entered the Chicago Police Academy in November 1967, and served as an officer for the Chicago Police Department for 35 years.

His assignments included the 12th, 25th and 20th districts; Area 4 and 5 Traffic; the Radar and Mass Transit units; and the Office of Special Events, coordinating police presence for major celebrations like the Taste of Chicago and the Columbus Day Parade.

After retiring with several honorable mentions in August 2002, he joined the Cook County State's Attorney's office as an investigator tasked with finding witnesses for cases. He retired from that position in 2016.

Ken has been and still is, on the Board of Directors of the Italian American Police Association for over 30 years.

Police Officer of the Year



Dominic Lupo Chicago Police Department

Officer Dominic Lupo Police Officer of the Year

My name is Domenic Lupo. I was born on the 23rd of July 1997 and am a 3rd generation Italian American. In 2014, while in high school, I enlisted into the United States Army and served as a Psychological Operations Specialist (MOS 37F) until 2020. During my time in the military, I learned how to work as a member of a team instead of working as an individual, along with putting others first that are in need of help. In 2018, I then decided to apply the skills I learned in the military to begin my career as a Chicago Police Officer. As a Chicago Police officer, I began my career working in patrol in the 006th district responding to calls where police service is needed. Now, I am currently assigned to the 006th district tactical team where I respond to violent crimes that are in progress.

Humanitarian Award



Dr. Willie L. Wilson Advocate of People in Need

Dr. Willie L. Wilson 2023 Humanitarian Award

Dr. Willie Wilson is a highly successful entrepreneur, philanthropist, and humanitarian. He is married and resides in Chicagoland area with his wife of more than twenty years. He has four grown children. Yet, his humble beginnings would hardly have predicted the success he has attained.

Born in Gilbert, Louisiana, Dr. Wilson was one of eleven children of Lula and Douglas Wilson. Sharecroppers, who worked in the cotton fields of Louisiana, his parents barely made enough money to meet the basic needs of their children. Life was very tough for Dr. Wilson and his family; and at only 13 years old, he decided to leave home in search of a better life. He left home with big dreams and a huge amount of determination and took a bus to Chicago to stay with a cousin.

In Chicago, Dr. Wilson supported himself with various laborer jobs, including working at a McDonald's restaurant in 1970 where he was the custodian, making \$2.00 an hour. His experiences working as a manager led to the aspiration to own a McDonald's himself and Dr. Wilson resolved to meet with Corporation founder, Ray Kroc. Impressed by his determination, intelligence and nerve, Kroc agreed to give him a McDonald's restaurant after a discussion at an annual shareholders' meeting in 1979. With capital provided by South Shore Bank, Dr. Wilson took a financially suffering Chicago franchise and turned it around within a year.

Displaying amazing business acumen, Wilson went on to purchase a total of five McDonald's restaurants over the next ten years; and received many "Outstanding Store Awards" from the Corporation.

Dr. Wilson had united with Christ Temple Missionary Baptist Church in ¬¬ 1973, where he is still a member today. There, he met the Norfleet Brothers, a gospel group that had toured the gospel circuit for several years. As his love for the Lord deepened, Dr. Wilson felt a strong affinity for praising God through singing. He joined the Norfleet Brothers and sang with them for several years. His love of gospel music led to Dr. Wilson's vision to start a production company, Willie Wilson Productions. This company premiered Singsation in 1989, a televised gospel show which was the first and only nationally syndicated gospel entertainment program on commercial television. This half hour show, hosted by Dr. Wilson, is aired on superstation WGN and is available in millions of households every Sunday.

Along the way, Wilson divested himself of all of the McDonald's restaurants so that he could devote more time to Singsation and to his involvement in bringing his gospel music ministry to churches throughout the world. He became a staunch supporter of the Chicago Baptist Institute International and is noted for providing significant financial support to the many churches that invite him to sing and speak before their congregations. In addition to producing five national gospel recordings, Dr. Wilson wrote an inspirational book chronicling his life story, "What Shall I Do Next, When I Don't Know Next What To Do?"

Dr. Wilson holds several Honorary Doctorate Degrees including an Honorary Doctorate in Divinity from Mt.

Carmel Theological Seminary, a Doctor of Humane letters from Chicago Baptist Institute, and an Honorary Doctorate in Humanitarianism from Swisher Bible College. Ever the entrepreneur, Dr. Wilson started Omar Medical Supplies Inc., in 1997, a company that is one of the largest black-owned company in Illinois. Distributing and importing a variety of products, including gloves, can liners, towels, tissues, safety supplies, etc., Omar sells to many of the country's Fortune 500 companies; and is one of the nation's fastest growing minority-owned companies in its field. With national and international distribution and warehousing capabilities, Dr. Wilson, as CEO, has guided Omar to the point that it is well poised for continued growth.

Dr. Wilson's life is a true embodiment of the American Dream--that hard work and persistence can overcome any obstacle. Dr. Wilson is an amazing man who has overcome many struggles in life: poverty; a child murdered in gang violence, failed relationships, prostate cancer, and a heart attack. Yet he perseveres and thrives.

Dr. Wilson is a sought-after speaker; and he profoundly inspires his audiences. He has the ability to provide pragmatic insights about running and growing a business; encouragement about what can be accomplished through hard work and determination; and spiritual motivation about faithfulness ... all in the same speech!

In 2015, 2019, and 2023, Dr. Wilson ran for Mayor of the city of Chicago seeking to address economic development, public safety, education and parity and fairness for all Chicago citizens.

In 2016, Dr. Wilson ran for President of the United States of America seeking to give voice to the issues of equal

opportunity for everyone, fairness for all our citizens and public safety.

In 2020, Dr. Wilson ran for the United States Senate seeking to address education, public safety, homelessness, and equal opportunity for all citizens.

As a humanitarian, Dr. Wilson provided over \$5 million to help churches, senior citizens, the Chicago police and fire departments, the Chicago Housing Authority and people struggling through COVID-19. In addition, he helped bail people out of Cook County Jail with misdemeanors. He donated millions to pay citizens property taxes to save their homes. When Hurricane Katrina and Ida struck New Orleans and Mississippi, Dr. Wilson gave away more than \$3 million to help people struggling. Most recently, Dr. Wilson donated more than \$5.2 million to help provide free gas, and groceries for people struggling with high inflation.

I began my Chicago Police career in June 1992 and was assigned to the 12th District upon graduating. I stayed in 012 until the CAPS program began in the early part of 1993 at which time I was sent to the 10th District, which was a CAPS prototype District. I remained in 010 until September 2004. My partner of many years had bid to the 19th District around 2000 and continuously requested I make the move to 019 also. In September 2004 I finally bid to 019. In December 2012 I was promoted to Sergeant and assigned to the 5th District. Seeing a need for a Sergeant Union Rep in 005 I inquired with then-President Jim Ade on how to fill that role. I was granted the 5th District Rep role which began my Sergeant Association path. I worked in 005 for about a year and then volunteered to move to Area South to work in Operation Impact, a team of young Officers assigned to the high-crime areas of the 5th District. In April 2014 I was asked to go back to 019. Once there I took over the Entertainment Team. The Entertainment Team was tasked with patrolling the nightclubs and bars of the 19th District namely Clark St, Halsted St, and Belmont Ave. In March 2016, I was approached by President Jim Ade to join the Sergeants' Association Board, a position that I immediately accepted. In October of 2017 the Board elections were held, I ran for and was elected to the position of Treasurer. In December of 2017, President Paul Bilotta requested that I go work in the Sergeants' Association office to function as

the Grievance Chairman. In March 2018 Vice President Chris Pettis was promoted to Lieutenant and President Paul Bilotta tasked me to fill the now-open role of Vice President and continue as the Grievance Chair. In April 2020 President Paul Bilotta was promoted to Lieutenant and the Board voted to have me finish Paul's term. In October 2020 the Board Elections were held and I ran for President and won with a large percentage of votes. (nearly 500 to less than 90). I am currently still serving the Sergeant Membership as the President which is a great honor. I joined the Knights of Columbus Police Council #12173 in early 2020 and was fortunate enough to progress to 4th Degree in 2021. This past June Grand Knight Dennis Fitzgerald and the Membership gave me the great honor of being named Deputy Grand Knight. And lastly but not in any way less than anything I have been blessed with, I have been a Den Leader for Boy Scout Pack #3617. This is something I feel is a rewarding experience for me, seeing the growth and maturing of the boys in the Den.






